Training Workshop – Core Concepts in Working with People From Refugee Backgrounds

Saturday 23rd October from 9.30am – 4.30pm at the Bathurst Uniting Church Activities Hall

The Bathurst Refugee Support Group is running a one-day introductory workshop designed to put a framework of understanding around working with refugees and asylum seekers. It focuses on understanding the link between what refugees have been through, the sorts of issues and behaviours they may present with, and how to work in a way that fosters feelings of trust, safety and control, while minimizing the risk of retraumatisation.

This workshop will be facilitated by the NSW Service for the Treatment and Rehabilitation of Torture and Trauma Survivors.

Have you got your vaccination proof?

There are a number of ways you can obtain proof:

- If you log onto your MyGov account at my.gov.au there are clear instructions on how to find your proof which you can then print.
- You can have the Medicare app on your smart phone and that will show your vaccination status.
- You can have a letter from your vaccination provider.
- You can contact the Australian Immunisation Register. Phone 1800 653 809, M-F, 8 a.m - 5 pm. It takes 14 days to get the document.
